Coronavirus Update April 6

As of this afternoon, 31 people in Suwannee County have tested positive for Covid-19. To date, there are no known cases at ACV, but we are aware of some people who have come in contact with known cases of the virus. We are taking precautions and following the directives of health officials, and now, more than ever, it is imperative that everyone follow the stay at home order given by the Governor.

Stay in your residence, whether that is an apartment or a single-family dwelling. Only come out for essential services, meals, groceries, medications, healthcare needs, exercising alone or taking care of a pet. Remember, the grocer and the pharmacy do deliver.

If you must interact with another, maintain a distance of more than six feet. Wash your hands often, avoid touching your face, nose, mouth and eyes with unclean hands, and disinfect frequently touched surfaces.

We will continue to screen employees, vendors and as able, visitors daily.

The shuttle will only make rounds from 8:00 - 9:00 am with pickup service available the rest of the day to take you to essential services. There is now only one drop off and pick up at Dollar General daily, during that early morning run. No additional off-campus trips will be made the rest of the day.

Copeland Clinic remains open but if you are running a fever or have Covid-19 symptoms, call before entering the building.

In a time like this, rumors have a way of spreading and they can be very harmful. Please do not participate in sharing unsubstantiated information. We will endeavor to keep you informed of the situation as it changes here at ACV.

As we begin holy week, remember the God of the universe loves each of us so much that He gave His only Son that whosoever believes in Him will not perish but have everlasting life. In John 16:33 our Savior states, "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world, you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."
